GUIDE TO APPLYING FOR INTERNSHIP ON THE KVB PORTAL

ACCOUNT ACTIVATION

Go to our website (kenyavetboard.or.ke) and click on portals. Click on **internship application**. Click on the **register account** button (at this point, do not put in any email or password. Fill in your details such as your names, email address, password and click the **register account** button. An "account confirmation" message shall be sent to your email. Follow the instructions and login using the email and password typed during the account registration process.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Navigate to the internship module. A red button shall appear called **New Internship Application**. Click it. Read the instructions and ensure you have the requirements ready before proceeding with the application.

Instructions

- 1. Fill in the online application form and wait for approval updates through email.
- 2. Applicants seeking to be registered as interns by the Kenya Veterinary Board must have been indexed and successfully graduated in either a Veterinary Medicine or Animal Health Course.
- 3. Every Veterinary Medicine or Animal Health graduate seeking to be registered by the Board must be a citizen of Kenya.
- 4. Veterinary Medicine applicants seeking for registration as interns shall fill the Form 40 document and the veterinarian's oath.
- 5. Animal Health applicants seeking for registration as interns shall fill the Form 40 document and the veterinary paraprofessionals oath.
- 6. Training institutions must forward the graduation lists of their students to the Board before registration of their graduates as interns.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Certified copy of National ID
- 2. Certified copy of Degree/Diploma/Certificate in Veterinary Medicine or Animal Health
- 3. Veterinarian's Oath/Veterinary Paraprofessional's Oath
- 4. Certified copy of K.C.S.E Certificate

NOTE:

<u>Copies of your documents (animal health/BVM certificate, National ID, KCSE Certificate)</u> need to be certified by an advocate/lawyer. Your application will not be accepted if they are not certified.

SERVICE FEES

Registration of Veterinary Surgeon Interns – Kshs. 1,000

Registration of Veterinary Paraprofessional Interns – Kshs. 500

Click the red button titled "Next". Fill in all the details in the different sections (Internship, Education history and Submit sections). Kindly note that for the education section, put in your KCSE and Animal Health/BVM details.



PAYMENT


For the payment process, your application will have a status that says "Make Payment". Click on that link.
